CONDITIONS FOR LINT IMPORTERS

- (a) The importer shall show financial ability endorsed by a reputable Bank/Financial Institution.
- (b) The applicant must be a member of Tanzania Cotton Association.
- (c) No importer shall import cotton lint without a valid import licence issued by the Board for every consignment.
- (d) **CONDITIONS FOR ISSUANCE OF EXPORT PERMITS**
 - 1. Lint importers must have to give reasons for importing cotton lint instead of buying within the Republic of Tanzania.
 - 2. Lint quality certificate issued by a competent body from the exporting country to be provided for every consignment.
- (e) Importers shall perfect the import permit issued for each consignment and return to the Board within 14 days from the date of shipment failure of which no Import Permit will be issued.
- (f) All lint importers must register every sale of cotton lint with the Board within seven (7) days from the date of sale otherwise the Board will not issue any Import Licence for any contract not registered. The information should include the importer's name, number of bales bought, the type, price and delivery period.
